We have been working alongside all the other primary schools in the cluster and Bedwas High School to develop a more consistent approach to positive behaviour management. This exciting project is being fully funded by the local authority and seeks to teach young people about the impact of their behaviour on others through supporting them to make better choices and giving them the skills to repair relationships when things go wrong. The system moves away from a notion of punishment and leans more towards rational consequences.
