- *Allow you to talk in a safe environment
- *Listen to you
- *Make sure that the school buildings and grounds are safe, secure and free from danger
- *Have members of staff who can offer help and support
- *Teach you to recognise risk and how to stay safe
- *Ask for help and support from other agencies on your behalf
