What shape are apples? What colours are apples? Name the parts of the apple – stem, pips, flesh, skin, core.</p> <p>Apples</p> <p>Activity 1: Use line, pattern and shape to create a Romero Britto style apple</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Look at and discuss the work of Brazilian artist Romero Britto – what can you see in his work? What colours, shapes and lines can you see? Do you like/dislike his work? Why? <p>Romero Britto</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practise drawing different lines, patterns and shapes. Model on board and ask pupils to copy. • Using the template of the apple (found in presentation), draw a selection of patterns in each area. Outline with a black pen and colour, using pencils, in the style of Britto. Ask pupils to concentrate on the colouring. 	
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
