Describe the properties of each shape. How many vertices/edges does a square/circle/triangle have? What is the difference between a square and a rectangle?</li> <li>• Model how to use scissors correctly. Ensure corners of each shape are evident. Remember the paper turns not the scissors.</li> <li>• Pupils cut out a selection of different shapes.</li> </ul>
