(Presentation below) Salvador Dali</p> <p>Activity 2: Melting clocks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Look at and discuss “The Persistence of Memory” in more detail. What can you see in the painting? Why do you think Dali chose melting clocks to paint? Why do you think he chose “The persistence of Memory” as a title? Critique the painting - What do you think of the painting? Explain your reasoning. • Using “Shrinking Plastic” sheets (or old plastic food containers), draw a large clock or watch. Draw large numbers and clock hands, colour using “Sharpie” pens and outline with a black sharpie. • The sheets will then be put in an oven and the plastic will shrink and curl and look as if they have melted. Explain to pupils that the plastic gets very hot and only adults must use the oven. | |
