1	WALT: Euros Sweepstake	Activity: To ease us into the final half term we will celebrate the euros by each randomly selecting a team. The winner at the end of the tournament will receive a prize on the last week of term!	ACL.3
2	WALT: Worries about Transition	Activity: We will talk about transition and some common worries that we are feeling across the class. We will discuss as a group and calm our nerves.	ECC.2
3	WALT: Sports Day Practice	Activity: This afternoon we will practice track and field events for sports day this Friday and establish who will be competing where	ACL.5

Tuesday

1	WALT: Gathering Data for Line Graph	Activity: Students will research the number of goals their sweepstake team has scored in each euro competition since 2000. This data will be collected to be put into a line graph in later lessons.	ACL.3
2	WALT: Warm Write – Recount Half Term	Activity: Students will ease back into extended writing, and we will establish a baseline writing ability to iron out any final worries and mistakes. The topic will be on what the students have been up to over half term.	ECC.2
3	WALT: What is the General Election?	Activity: We will learn about the importance of the general election and hold our own referendum in class. Students will create scripts and parties in groups with their own manifestos to improve school life.	ACL.5

Wednesday

1	WALT: Line Graph Reasoning	Activity: Students will get the chance to look at some examples of line graphs and identify the key features before creating their own later in the week.	ACL.5
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2	WALT: Two Page Spread - Argument	Activity: Here students can explore the genre of a balanced argument and research what language they need to use to make an effective argument. This work will be updated regularly as we progress through the topic.	ACL.9
3	WALT: Tennis Sessions	Activity: Students will be able to take part in a tennis session this afternoon learning the way to hold a racket and effectively strike the ball.	HCL.1

Thursday

1	WALT: Line Graph Creation	Activity: After seeing some examples of line graphs and understanding the necessary features, we will now use our data from Tuesday's lesson to show the form that each team has been in since 2000 through a line graph.	ACL.1
2	WALT: Cold Write - Argument	Activity: Here students will apply their limited knowledge of argumentative writing to argue why their team will win the euros. We will then analyse mistakes and work through the literacy process to produce a hot write later in the term.	ACL.1
3	WALT: Class Referendum	Activity: Students will hold a live debate at the front of the class with their representatives and take turns to answer difficult questions from a host. Then we will hold a ballot to see which party will represent the class.	EIC.5

1	WALT: Missions	Activity: This time will be used for accessing and completing any missions that have been started during reading time this week. Missions are independent tasks that recap knowledge from the previous two weeks.	ACL.4
2	WALT: Consolidation and catch up	Activity: This time is dedicated for improving, reflecting and building on the work produced this week. This allows time for me to provide individualised feedback to each student on their progress and where there is room to improve in each area of learning.	ACL.1
3	WALT: Sports Day	Activity: Our jigsaw theme this term is relationships, and we will be looking this week at what the term mental health refers to through engaging activities.	HCL.1
