1	WALT: Fractions, Decimals and Percentages: Test	Activity: Today we will test our knowledge of the fractions, decimals and percentages topic. This is not a formal test, rather used to gauge whether we need to revisit this topic before the end of the year.	ACL.3
2	WALT: Final prep for Hot Write	Activity: Students will choose one of the four researched poetry forms and create their own poem using the rhyme scheme, structure, wow words and key words that they have explored during warm up activities.	ECC.2
3	WALT: Inheritance of genes and the passing on of traits	Activity: Using our class dojos as examples, we will explore what traits are passed on and investigate the reasons behind this including	EIC.5

1	WALT: Area and Perimeter	Activity: Starting a new maths topic on area and perimeter, we will begin to look at length x width to find area and the calculations needed to find the perimeter of rectangles.	ACL.3
2	WALT: Adapting the human body	Activity: Students will draw around each other in groups to create a life size outline of the human body. Then each group will choose a climate or environment which they must adapt their drawing to. For example, students may decide on giving their human gills to survive and breathe under water. We will then discuss as a class why they have chosen these adaptations for the specific climate.	ECC.2
